A RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE TALBOT COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE WATER & SEWER PLAN, AS ADOPTED BY TALBOT COUNTY RESOLUTION 100, TO EXTEND THE SERVICE AREA OF THE EASTON WATER AND WASTEWATER SYSTEM TO CERTAIN AREAS THAT INCLUDE TAX MAP 34, PARCEL 126, AS W-1 AND S-1, IN THE FIRST ELECTION DISTRICT, TALBOT COUNTY, MARYLAND; PURSUANT TO THE POWER AND AUTHORITY CONTAINED IN THE ENVIRONMENTAL ARTICLE, TITLE 9, SUBTITLE 5, OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND

RESOLUTION NO. 111

A RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE TALBOT COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE WATER & SEWER PLAN, AS ADOPTED BY TALBOT COUNTY RESOLUTION 100, TO EXTEND THE SERVICE AREA OF THE EASTON WATER AND WASTEWATER SYSTEM TO CERTAIN AREAS THAT INCLUDE TAX MAP 34, PARCEL 126, AS W-1 AND S-1, IN THE FIRST ELECTION DISTRICT, TALBOT COUNTY, MARYLAND; PURSUANT TO THE POWER AND AUTHORITY CONTAINED IN THE ENVIRONMENTAL ARTICLE, TITLE 9, SUBTITLE 5, OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND

WHEREAS, The Talbot County Council adopted Resolution 100 (October 22, 2002), which was based on the October 2002 Report of the Review of the Comprehensive Water and Sewerage Plan; and

WHEREAS, The owners of certain real property in the First Election District have requested to extend the service area of the Easton Water and Wastewater Systems; and

WHEREAS, The Town of Easton, in the First Election District, Talbot County has processed these requests to extend the service area and program the water and sewer service designations of the Easton Water and Wastewater Systems; and

WHEREAS, The Talbot County Council has considered the request, and hereby approves the same, subject to the terms of this Resolution and compliance with applicable design and technical requirements, rules, and regulations of all local, state, and federal authorities; and

WHEREAS, Talbot County has verified that, including the facility approved by this amendment, water and sewer service to its Immediate Priority (W-1, S-1) Schedule will be properly planned, controlled, and regulated; and

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the County Council of Talbot County, Maryland as follows:

Section 1. The Talbot County Comprehensive Water and Sewerage Plan shall be amended to include an immediate priority classification for water and sewer service (W-1, S-1) extensions in the jurisdiction of the Easton Water and Wastewater Systems to the following area:

1. TAX MAP 34, PARCEL 126 (Proposed Easton Village Development)

Section 2. The Talbot County Comprehensive Water and Sewerage Plan shall be amended to reclassify the property referred to as Tax Map 34, Parcel 126 from W-2, S-2 to W-, S-1, immediate priority status.

Section 3. The Amendment to include immediate priority status for water and sewer utilities extension (W-1, S-1) shall be in accordance with the attached additions and changes and shall be permanently entered into the currently effective Comprehensive Water and Sewerage Plan as part of Chapters 1, 2, and 3.

Section 4. Water and sewer service allocation to Tax Map 34, Parcel 126 (Proposed Easton Village Development) with the W-1, S-1 classifications shall be consistent with the Town of Easton's Sewer Allocation Program.

Section 5. The Town of Easton shall submit to the Talbot County Health Department reports identifying the allocation of sewer for newly created lots and the remaining capacity of the Easton Wastewater Treatment Plant;

Section 6. Inclusion of the proposed utility extension, planned for immediate priority in the Talbot County Comprehensive Water and Sewerage Plan, shall record capacity demand increases, as identified herein, on the serving wastewater treatment facilities.

Section 7. Adoption of this amendment, by the County Council of Talbot County, shall authorize the construction of the projects in accordance with and subject to the approval of the Municipal, County, State, and/or Federal agencies, as may be required, effective from the date of adoption.

Be It Further Resolved that this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its date of passage.
